What is the Aid Management Program?

Development Gateway's Aid Management Program provides technical assistance and capacity building to improve the availability of aid information at the country level. Through a combination of process analysis and training, Development Gateway works with clients to create a customized package of support for better aid information management.

The Aid Management Program was created by Development Gateway in collaboration with the OECD, World Bank, UNDP, and governments of Ethiopia and India. Anchored in the principles of the global aid effectiveness agenda, the Program contributes to aid coordination and harmonization, helping governments and their donor partners manage for results.

How the Program Works

There are two primary components to the Aid Management Program: 1) tools including the Aid Management Platform (AMP) and ODAdata, aid information management systems that enable government and donor staff to collect, report, and monitor information on development assistance; and 2) institutional strengthening activities, which build capacity for sustainable program management. These activities include training, technical support, process analysis, and knowledge-sharing workshops. These components are implemented over a multi-year period using a programmatic approach that aims to ensure government ownership and sustainability.



21 implementations worldwide

The Aid Management Program has been implemented in 21 countries around the world, each with different needs and capabilities.

The Program at a Glance

- Implementations in 21 countries, including the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Haiti, Kosovo, Lao PDR, Nepal, and Tanzania
- Over 10,000 projects recorded in AMP systems, accounting for billions of dollars in foreign aid
- Twelve aid reports have been produced using AMP data and analytical tools
- Surveys indicate that AMP drastically reduces time taken to collect accurate data and produce reports
- AMP used by 5 of top 10 recipients of Official Development Assistance (ODA), measured as a percentage of Gross National Income (GNI)
- Governments are pursuing aid transparency by publishing aid information online – for example, see Kosovo's AMP Public View (www.amp-mei.net)



Enabling efficient aid information management

The Aid Management Program combines software solutions with capacity-building activities, such as this workshop hosted by Ethiopia in 2007 for delegates from Burkina Faso, Tanzania, and Malawi.

“With AMP, we can trace aid flows that come from the exterior to Burundi, whether from multilateral or bilateral agencies, or even from NGOs. Subsequently, we can produce reports and document all these aid flows, not only for the use of the government, but as well as for civil society [and] for donors.”

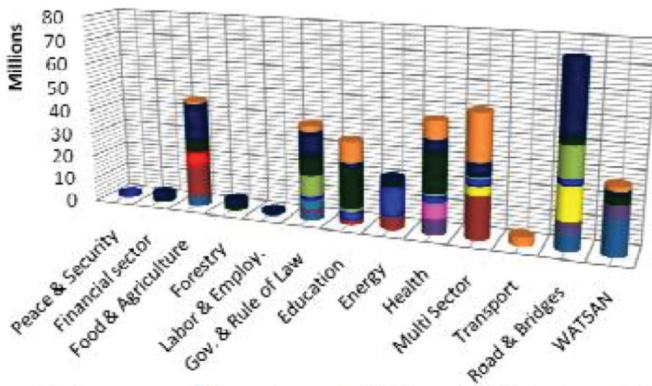

AMP Features

Aid Information and Reporting

- Capture information on individual aid projects, including donor, sector, fiscal year, region, and more
- Produce custom reports complete with sophisticated analytical charts, graphs, and tables

Dashboards and Mapping

- Create charts and graphs displaying aid information
- View donor aid profiles

Collaboration Tools

- Communicate and schedule tasks through messaging and calendar modules

Monitoring and Evaluation

- Access real-time qualitative information on individual projects
- Track progress in achieving indicators of project success

Capacity-Building

To enable governments to effectively manage and track aid, capacity-building activities are embedded in the program from assessment through post-implementation.
